Reaseheath is privileged to provide this key service at the world's most famous equine event. HOYS organisers value our students' enthusiasm, high standards and work ethic and as a result we have been invited to fulfil this role for the past 12 years.

All students can apply. Those selected enjoy an action packed week assisting international show jumping course designers and builders, supporting high level dressage, pony club and driving competitions, and meeting elite riders and trainers.

We also provide arena parties and event support for British Eventing, The British Dressage National Championships and



other high profile competitions across the north west.

Shows and events

We run our own schedule of affiliated and unaffiliated competitions in dressage, showing, show jumping and combined training, all supported by students. We also provide opportunities for students to train and compete in inter-college and National Schools Equestrian Competitions.

Lecture demonstrations

We host elite equestrian athletes for public demonstrations. These have included members of the British squad at the upcoming 2024 Olympics such as Eventing World Champion Ros Canter, show jumpers Ben Maher and Joe Stockdale and Chinese eventer Alex Hua Tian.

We work with leading industry employers to ensure you develop key technical career skills and provide immersive industry experiences at a range of leading equine businesses.
