Funding your future

Whether you want to study a part-time leisure course or a full-time professional qualification, you may be able to benefit from one of our financial support options.

College Bursary Fund

You may be entitled to receive financial support to study your full time Level 3 qualification, which can help with things such as:

- **Childcare, if you are under the age of 20 at the start of your course**
- **Course materials, uniform or equipment**
- **Travel costs**

Free courses available

If you are aged 19 – 23 and want to study your first full Level 2 or 3 qualification, you may be entitled to study for free through the Adult Skills Fund. Free courses may also be available if you are currently earning less than £25,000* or you are unemployed.

Advanced Learner Loan

If you are aged 19 or over and want to study a Level 3 qualification, the Advanced Learner Loan could cover your tuition fees, if you are not eligible for funding from the Adult Skills Fund, to help support you in a change of career.

With an Advanced Learner Loan:

- **You don't pay back a penny until your income is over £25,000 a year**
- **No credit checks and a low interest rate**
- **Your household income isn't taken into account**
- **You can fast-track your career**

Advanced Learner Loans are also available for our Level 3 Access to Higher Education Diploma, and if you successfully complete a degree after the course, the outstanding balance from this loan will be written off.

*Please note income eligibility may vary depending on where you live.

Once you have found the course for you, you will be ready to enrol. Some courses may require you to complete a short application form. Once we have received your application a member of our team will be in contact to discuss your next steps.

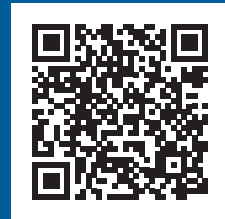
