

Multiply does not require a work placement and you do not need to contribute to the training.


Please note - employees do not have to live in Cheshire East to be eligible for the course, as long as the employer is based in Cheshire East.




Success Story

Sarah completed our 'Pizza & Programming course in June 2024. She is now enrolled on 'Access to HE' at Reaseheath College.

"I'm very grateful to Victoria and the college for the opportunity to do the Pizza and Programming course. I had been out of education for 10 years, was stuck in a low paid job and had lost confidence in my ability to learn. I have always struggled with maths but the Multiply course gave me some confidence back and with Victoria's encouragement I applied to study an Access to HE course. I am now studying the access course with plans to start a degree in 2025. I wouldn't have had the confidence to do this without the Pizza and Programming course."





Learner Progression

In the 2023/24 financial year, 50% of learners (who joined Multiply courses designed to help them progress onto Function Skills) enrolled on one of our evening courses - spanning both Level 1 and Level 2.

This term, Springboard has boosted its number of October Functional Skills Maths enrolments by welcoming a new cohort of Multiply learners.

Maths tutor, Linda, says, "Multiply is a fantastic way of introducing learners to Functional Skills maths. As well as engaging in activities that underpin the mathematical skills and understanding required to progress onto Functional Skills Maths, our classes have a strong social element. We focus on working together and team building. As well as boosting learners' confidence we develop employability skills and techniques that will support their onward journey".
